Wind-Pump Irrigation Report

This leaflet gives a brief report on the current status of each of our wind-pump irrigation projects. In each of these projects the wind-pump enables 50 acres of land to be irrigated and two crops to be grown each year. Farmers keep 50% of their crops for their own use. The remaining 50% is sold and used to provide income for community projects in the area.
